**LOCAL RULES**

(to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

- OUT OF BOUNDS**  
The course is bounded by the line of white posts with black tops to the right of the 1st Hole of the 'STONEY CREEK' Course & 10th Hole of the 'DEWHURST' Course and elsewhere by such posts or the club's boundary fence.
- STAKED TREES & SHRUBS**  
If a staked tree or staked shrub interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, the player MUST take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b(i).a
- STAKES, ROPES & HOOPS**  
All stakes, ropes and protective metal hoops MUST be treated as immovable obstructions, relieve MAY be taken as provided in Rule 24-2b(i).
- STONES IN BUNKERS**  
Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
- FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**  
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from such interference by them MAY be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, then the player MAY take relief without penalty as follows:  
If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) no nearer the hole (b) avoids such intervention (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- GARDEN BEDS**  
Garden bed are ground under repair and the player MUST take relief as provided in Rule 25-1.
- WHEEL MARKS**  
Except in a hazard, wheel ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle may be treated as ground under repair. The player MAY take relief as provided in Rule 25-1.
- AREA MARKINGS**  
Water Hazard Yellow stakes and / or lines.  
Lateral Water Hazard Red stakes and / or lines.  
Ground Under Repair White stakes and / or lines.  
Out of Bounds White posts with Black Tops.
- PATHS**  
ALL CONSTRUCTED pathways and their integral drainage are to be treated as immovable obstructions. Relief MAY be taken as provided in Rule 24-2b(i).
